Buy In/Substitution Rules

Weekly buy-in will be collected every Friday before matches begin; \$25 for each player will be put into the pot. This will be the buy-in weekly no matter the tournament size or format (2v2, 3v3, 4v4).

Substitutions will be handled by the captains. If a team needs a substitution, they must allow the captains to vote on the player coming into the match to ensure team balance and tournament integrity. The substituting player will also pay the \$25 buy in, and the original buy-in from the player subbing out will not be refunded.

These buy-in rules are to enforce competitive integrity and not allow losing teams to force a substitution and disrupt the tournament's flow.

Weekly Captains

Captains will now be picked based on the most recent Friday tournament results. The last place team will all be split and each player will become a captain.

If the following week requires more captains than the previous weeks losing team had, we will look at the overall individual statistics to determine the remaining captain spots.

Ex: If the last place team was in a 3v3 format, those 3 become captains. If we need 4 captains next week, the next lowest individual performer will take that final captain position.

Draft

The weekly draft is simple; after the captains are finalized, it is a snake style draft. In the event a player drops out of the tournament, this will always result in a redraft.

Pool Play/Bracket Format

Every week's tournament will start with a pool play round robin style to determine bracket seeding. Pool play matches will be a one and done match with the map being randomly drawn from the map pool.

Bracket format will always be double elimination with a “bracket reset” in grand finals. All bracket matches will be played in a “Best of 5” format.

Grand Finals rules will use a bracket reset in the event it needs one. If the team coming from loser's bracket wins the first best of 5, the bracket will then reset, and they will then have to win another best of 5 to win the tournament. If this occurs, each team will go back through the map pick/veto system to set up the final series. This ensures the team coming out of the winner's side is not at a disadvantage and is given the same benefit as the rest of the bracket.

Weekly Statistics

For weekly stats, we ask a player from each team to take a screenshot of the final leaderboards of EACH map and post it in the “weekly statistics” chat channel in the Friday Night 8’s discord. These will all be dumped into an excel sheet to keep track of the overall league and also help with captain selections on a weekly basis.

This statistics sheet will also keep track of the weekly winners, cash earned, and which format each week was won.
